EU RoHS & WEEE COMPLIANCE DECLARATION

1. European Union RoHS

We confirm that products supplied by us comply with the applicable substance restrictions of EU Directive 2011/65/EU, as amended, including Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 (RoHS).

Based on current material declarations and compliance information obtained from our manufacturing and material suppliers, the products supplied by us do not contain restricted substances above the applicable maximum concentration values established by RoHS.

The ten restricted substances are:

- Lead (Pb)
- Mercury (Hg)
- Cadmium (Cd)
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr VI)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)

The applicable maximum concentration values are 0.1% by weight in homogeneous material for the majority of restricted substances and 0.01% for cadmium.

Where RoHS exemptions apply to particular applications or materials, the relevant regulatory exemption is taken into account in determining compliance.

2. UK RoHS

Products supplied for the United Kingdom market are managed in accordance with the applicable requirements of the Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations (UK RoHS).

Our RoHS compliance information is maintained using supplier material declarations and product information applicable to the products concerned.

3. EU WEEE

We support downstream customers with relevant product and material information for products falling within the scope of the EU Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Directive 2012/19/EU.

Product stewardship, registration, collection and other producer obligations are managed by the applicable economic operator in accordance with the requirements applying in the relevant market.

We do not manufacture or materially alter the electrical and electronic equipment supplied.

We confirm our commitment to supporting customers with the product information required for downstream WEEE compliance.

REACH & POPs COMPLIANCE DECLARATION

1. European Union REACH

We monitor compliance with Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH).

Based on current material declarations and compliance information obtained from our manufacturing and material suppliers, products supplied by us comply with applicable REACH requirements.

We monitor the ECHA Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) and maintain relevant supplier information concerning substances present in articles.

Where information concerning an SVHC is required under REACH Article 33, the relevant information is communicated through the supply chain.

2. SCIP

We maintain the product and material information necessary to support applicable SCIP obligations for articles containing Candidate List SVHCs above 0.1% w/w.

Where a SCIP notification is required for an article placed on the EU market by us, the relevant information is maintained and the applicable notification requirement is addressed.

3. UK REACH

Products supplied for the United Kingdom market are managed in accordance with the applicable requirements of UK REACH, including requirements relating to substances contained in articles and communication of relevant substance information through the supply chain.

4. Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs)

We monitor compliance with the EU Regulation on Persistent Organic Pollutants (Regulation (EU) 2019/1021) and applicable international controls established under the Stockholm Convention.

Based on current supplier material declarations and product information, products supplied by us comply with applicable restrictions on regulated persistent organic pollutants.

US TSCA & CRITICAL MATERIALS COMPLIANCE

1. US TSCA Section 6(h) PBT Restrictions

We monitor the applicable requirements of the United States Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6(h) concerning persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT) chemicals.

Based on current material declarations and compliance information obtained from our manufacturing and material suppliers, products supplied by us do not contain or incorporate the five PBT chemicals subject to the applicable TSCA Section 6(h) restrictions in circumstances prohibited by those requirements.

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

We monitor relevant changes to these requirements through its ongoing compliance procedures.

2. Critical Raw Materials

We recognise the importance of secure, responsible and resilient sourcing of critical raw materials used in industrial and electrical products.

Relevant information concerning critical raw materials is incorporated into our supplier and material compliance review where appropriate.

We maintain available material and sourcing information to support customer supply-chain due diligence requirements.

PFAS, PROPOSITION 65 & PACKAGING COMPLIANCE

1. Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS)

We monitor developments concerning per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) and applicable restrictions and reporting requirements in the markets served by our company.

Based on current material declarations and compliance information obtained from our manufacturing and material suppliers, we are not aware of intentionally added PFAS in its standard metals, plastics and electrical component product ranges.

2. California Proposition 65

We monitor the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (Proposition 65) and the associated list of chemicals published by the State of California.

Based on current supplier material declarations and product information available to us, we are not aware of the products we supply requiring a Proposition 65 warning under their intended and reasonably foreseeable use.

3. Packaging, Packaging Waste & Extended Producer Responsibility

We manage packaging used in the distribution of our products in accordance with applicable packaging and packaging-waste requirements in the markets served.

Packaging materials are selected and managed with regard to applicable requirements concerning restricted substances, packaging waste, recycling and material recovery.

We maintain relevant information concerning packaging materials used in the supply of our products and supports customer packaging and Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) requirements.

For the European Union, we monitor the requirements of the Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR) together with applicable national EPR requirements.

4. Packaging Heavy Metals

Packaging materials supplied by us are managed in accordance with applicable restrictions concerning lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium.

Our supplier and packaging controls are designed to support compliance with applicable concentration limits for these substances in packaging.

5. EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR)

We monitor the EU Deforestation Regulation (Regulation (EU) 2023/1115) and its application to relevant products and materials.

We maintain procedures to identify and address EUDR requirements where they apply to products or materials supplied by the company.

TRADE SANCTIONS, RESPONSIBLE MINERALS & ETHICAL SUPPLY CHAIN

1. Trade Sanctions & Restricted-Country Controls

We maintain formal policies and procedures designed to ensure that our purchasing, sales and distribution activities comply with applicable sanctions, export controls, customs requirements and other trade restrictions.

We do not knowingly undertake transactions in breach of applicable trade sanctions or restrictions.

Our compliance procedures take account of supplier information, country-of-origin information available to us and applicable trade restrictions relevant to the products and transactions concerned.

2. Responsible Minerals & Conflict Minerals

We maintain policies and procedures supporting responsible sourcing of minerals used in the products we distribute.

Where applicable, information concerning Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten and Gold (3TG) is obtained through our manufacturing and material supply chain and is reviewed as part of our responsible-minerals due diligence.

We maintain relevant supplier and material information in support of responsible-minerals and conflict-minerals compliance requirements.

For other minerals, including cobalt and lithium, relevant sourcing information is incorporated into our supply-chain review where available.

3. Modern Slavery, Forced Labour & Child Labour

We maintain a zero-tolerance approach to modern slavery, forced labour, human trafficking and child labour.

We expect our manufacturing and supply-chain partners to maintain equivalent standards and to comply with applicable labour, employment and human-rights requirements.

We maintain an Ethical Trading Policy setting out our expectations concerning ethical conduct and responsible practices throughout our supply chain.

Our approach is aligned with the principles of the UK Modern Slavery Act 2015, the Canada Fighting Against Forced Labour and Child Labour in Supply Chains Act, and internationally recognised principles concerning responsible business conduct and human rights.

We conduct appropriate supply-chain due diligence and expect suppliers to identify and address risks associated with forced labour, child labour and other forms of labour exploitation.

4. Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act (UFLPA)

We monitor the requirements of the United States Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act (UFLPA) and related US forced-labour import controls.

Our compliance procedures take account of available supplier, country-of-origin and upstream sourcing information relevant to UFLPA requirements.

We do not knowingly supply products in circumstances that would breach applicable UFLPA requirements.

COMPLIANCE COMMITMENT

We are committed to maintaining appropriate regulatory and supply-chain compliance procedures and to keeping relevant supplier and product information under review as regulations develop.

The information contained in this statement represents our current compliance position based on information available to our company and its established supply-chain due-diligence processes.
